Program: Departure from Rabat at 7:30 am. Arrival in Fez; Bab Boujloud (blue door) at 10 am. The program will start with a sightseeing tour of the city with a local guide, who will give you more information about the city and its attractions. This will be followed by a visit of the Medina (old city) on foot, the Bouanania and the Attarine Medersas constructed in the early 14th century by the Merinides dynasty, the Karaouine Mosque (The ancient educational centre of Islamic learning), and the Nejjarine Marble Fountain. After a lunch break in a typical Moroccan restaurant (El Patio bleu), the decorated gate of the medieval tanneries will be visited, followed by the Souks (local markets) where merchants and craftsmen sell their hand-made jewellery, leather goods, copperware and pottery. The return to Rabat city is scheduled at 6 pm.
